

Early Childhood Development Classroom completed!



We are pleased to announce that the ECD classroom at the Olemoncho Primary School has been completed on time and within budget! Olemoncho school serves the rural area of Aitong in the Masai mara and is the main school for the children of Masai herders. The school has successfully completed four projects with the Kenyan School Project and the school management committee, teachers and parents are working hard to better serve the approximately 350 students at the school. Girls represent 46% of the student population and the school administration is working to help girls stay in school.

Board member, Ann Goss visited the Olemoncho school the first week in April of this year and met with the Head Teacher and school management committee to review the schools' goals and achievements.

Next step – computers.

The management committee has identified the pressing need for the school to obtain a computer program to propel their students into the growing digital age. We at KSP recognize that the next generation of Kenyans' must be equipped and trained in technology if they are to compete in the job market.

Olemoncho has applied for a grant from the KSP to fund a computer program. This proposal is the largest project that KSP has taken on and will require matching grants and larger donations than ever before, but we believe we are up to the challenge of raising the funds needed for this project. Therefore, we have launched a Computers for Olemoncho school fundraising campaign.

The KSP Board is currently discussing the details of the next project and will announce our plan in the new year. Meanwhile, we want to thank you for your ongoing support for our work. Please consider a year-end donation to support the Computers for Olemoncho school fundraising campaign.
